From the Baltimore Area

From I-695 East (Baltimore Beltway), take Exit 4, I-97 South, on the left toward Annapolis/Bay Bridge. Merge onto Route 50 and follow it all the way to Worcester County & Ocean City.

From Hagerstown, MD

Take I-70 South to I-695 East (Baltimore Beltway), take Exit 4, I-97 South, on the left toward Annapolis/Bay Bridge. Merge onto Route 50 and follow it all the way to Worcester County & Ocean City.

From Washington, DC

I-495 (Capital Beltway) take Exit 19A, Route 50 East toward Annapolis/Bay Bridge and follow it all the way to Worcester County & Ocean City.

From Philadelphia & Points North

... such as Trenton and New York City, take I-95 South to exit 4B, Christiana Mall, in Northern Delaware, Route 1 South to Dover. Merge onto Route 113 South to Worcester County & then Route 90 East or Route 50 East to Ocean City.

From Central Pennsylvania

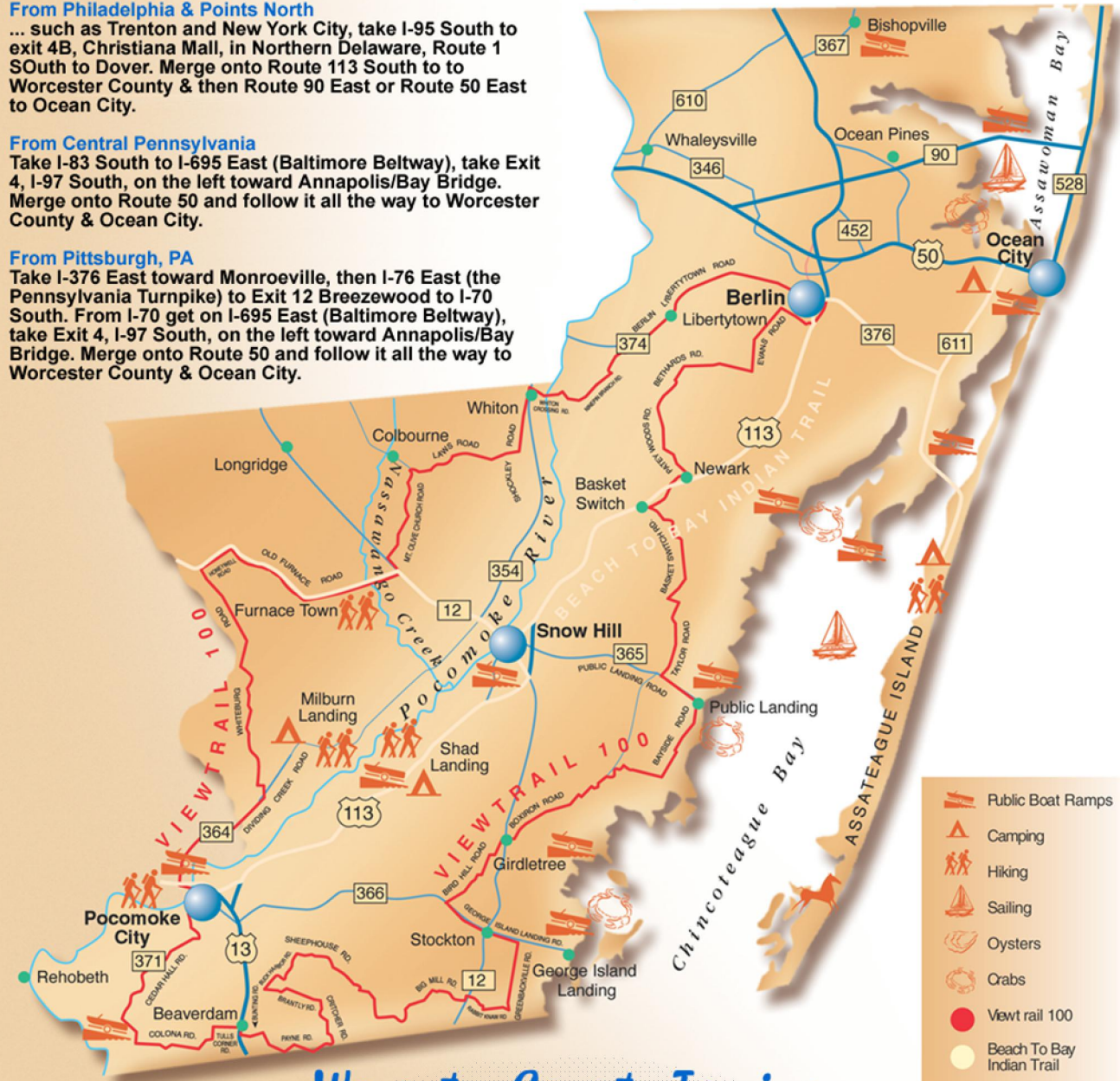
Take I-83 South to I-695 East (Baltimore Beltway), take Exit 4, I-97 South, on the left toward Annapolis/Bay Bridge. Merge onto Route 50 and follow it all the way to Worcester County & Ocean City.

From Pittsburgh, PA

Take I-376 East toward Monroeville, then I-76 East (the Pennsylvania Turnpike) to Exit 12 Breezewood to I-70 South. From I-70 get on I-695 East (Baltimore Beltway), take Exit 4, I-97 South, on the left toward Annapolis/Bay Bridge. Merge onto Route 50 and follow it all the way to Worcester County & Ocean City.

Situated conveniently in the Mid-Atlantic region, Worcester County is readily accessible by road or air from most of the east coast of the United States. In fact it is an easy drive for one-third of the nations population!
